

Biography: Prof. Manuel MAYR, MD, PhD

Manuel Mayr is the British Heart Foundation (BHF) Professor for Cardiovascular Proteomics. He qualified in Medicine from the University of Innsbruck (Austria) in 1999. After his medical degree, he worked at the Austrian Academy of Sciences from 1999 to 2001. In 2001, he moved to London to undertake a PhD, on the topic of “*Cardiovascular Proteomics: Linking Proteomic and Metabolomic Changes*”. He obtained a BHF Intermediate Research Fellowship in 2005 and was successful in obtaining a BHF Senior Research Fellowship and achieved promotion to Professor in 2011. In 2017, he has been awarded a BHF Personal Chair, which he moved to Imperial College London in 2023. His group uses proteomics in combination with other -omics technologies to integrate biological information in disease-specific networks that drive pathophysiological changes (*Nat Rev Cardiol.* 2021;18(5):313-330). His academic achievements have been recognised by the President's Distinguished Lecture of the International Society for Heart Research (2022).
