Mauro Giacca, MD PhD, is Head of the School of Cardiovascular and Metabolic Medicine&Sciences at King's College London. Until 2019, he has served as Director-General of the ICGEB, a United Nations research organization. Prof Giacca is considered an expert in gene and RNA therapy for cardiovascular disorders. He leads a recently established MRC/BHF Centre for Cardiac Repair and Regeneration (REACT) and is Co-Director of the BHF Centre of Research Excellence at King's. His research is funded internationally, including 3 consecutive European Commission ERC Advanced grants and 2 consecutive Leducq Foundation grants. Prof Giacca is an elected Fellow of the Academy of Medical Sciences, UK and a past-President of the International Society for Heart Research (ISHR)-European Section. He is the founder of Forcefield Therapeutics and Heqet Therapeutics, which develop biologics for myocardial infarction and heart failure.
