Professor Roger Foo is the inaugural chair holder of the Zayed Bin Sultan Al Nahyan Professorship of Medicine and Vice Dean (Research) at the NUS Yong Loo Lin School of Medicine. He is also Director of the National University Health System (NUHS) Cardiovascular Research Institute (CVRI) and Senior Consultant at the National University Heart Centre Singapore (NUHCS), where he serves as the Clinical Lead for the Cardiac Genetics Service.

A cardiac geneticist with specific interest in cardio-metabolism, Prof Foo has established Singapore's first Cardiac Genetics clinical service and has published widely in the field of Cardiovascular Molecular Epigenetics and Cell Biology. Prof Foo trained and worked in Cambridge, UK, for over 20 years, before moving his lab to Singapore in 2013. Research in his lab continues to use genomic technology to study the cardiac epigenome and hunt for novel heart failure mechanisms.
